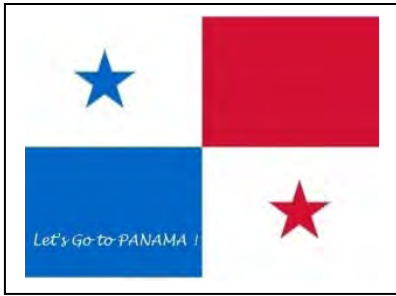


# Investment Group Trip to Panama 2010

## Day 1 – June 10, Thursday

## Day 2 – June 11, Friday - Panama City



Final arrivals into Panama City with shuttle service to the hotel. Breakfast included at the hotel for those who arrived the day before. Lunch is on your own. Our first evening in Panama together takes place at the "Las Tinajas" Restaurant (\$10+ per person). We will see and taste the flavors and folklore of Panama. Las Tinajas features costumed folkloric performances, which will excite you and give you a warm welcome to Panama. They feature authentic cuisine based on a collection of the best traditional Panamanian recipes from around the country, carefully prepared by their chefs with the freshest native ingredients. ## Day 3 – June 12, Saturday - Panama Canal Tour



After breakfast, we embark on a tour through the Panama Canal. Our Tour starts at the Miraflores aboard the "Fantasía del Mar" boat, capable of carrying 500 passengers. Aboard, we will enjoy lunch and light drinks

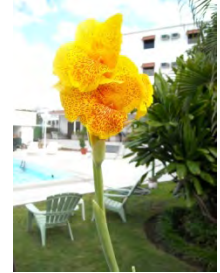

## Day 4 – June 13, Sunday - Taboga Island

After breakfast we head to the Castaway, and board the tour boat to the Island of Taboga. We will spend the day on the Island of Taboga enjoying the sun, swim in the warm waters, stroll along its flower-lined paths, walk its nature trails, smell the roses, explore and discover, and enjoying yourselves. Taboga is a place where there are no cars, no consumer price tags, no pushing and shoving... just peace. It's the Island of Flowers - an island of perennial blossoms, humble people, and a very special paradise. The months of January through April are considered high season for visitors. There is no shortage of parridillas or carbónarias in Panama City, but the best value in all of Panama is the Columbian-owned Leños y Carbón. This new restaurant is located at the end of the Amador Causeway with breathtaking views of the Panama skyline. They offer a wide variety of grilled meats - chicken, beef, and pork. They also offer an assortment of fresh fruit juices & sodas. (B, D)

## Day 5 – June 14, Monday - Farallon

After breakfast, we check out of our hotel & leave Panama City to Farallon for the fantastic fun-filled RCI Gold Crown Resort of Decameron - about two hours drive. Upon check-in enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure at this ALL-INCLUSIVE resort. For the next 2 nights, relax, eat, and drink all you want. Alcoholic beverages are included such as blended Piña Colodas, Strawberry Margaritas, etc. You will receive a dining schedule, maps, and information upon arrival. Casco Antiguo or Casco Viejo is a charming city within a city, reminiscent of New Orleans, old San Juan, Puerto Rico and Cartagena, Colombia, amongst others. Undergoing a major facelift, it offers a unique setting sandwiched between the





Panama Canal and ultramodern Panama City. When the Casco Antiguo quarter reconstruction is rendered, it will be unique in the world. Many savvy investors are flocking here to purchase & restore buildings, hotels for remodel and operating chic boutiques, inns and bistros that will differentiate the area from others. Others are just looking for a unique place to live in the tropics, in a diminutive version of Florence or Paris, mixed with the gusto of Havana and Madrid. The government of Panama recently enacted legislation that allows for generous incentives to investors and residents, such as a 30-year



homeowner's tax exemption, subsidized construction, remodeling and mortgage interest rates, duty-free importation of construction materials and sales tax/personal income tax exemptions on remodeled structures sales and rentals. After the city tour we return to the hotel to refresh and get ready for the Farewell Night Cruise on the Bay of Panama.

## GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

**Tour Cost:** All quoted prices are based upon our contract with the tour suppliers and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

**Reservations and Payment:** Creative Destinations Group requires a **deposit of \$500.00** per person at the time of booking. Final payment due dates are as stated on the first page of the booking form. Checks or credit cards are accepted. A \$25 fee will be assessed for returned checks.

**Cancellation and Refunds:** Please make all cancellations in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply in addition to any charges assessed by our suppliers. If cancelled on or after May 10, 2010, \$500 will be charged. If cancelled 30 days prior or no shows are charged 100% of the tour price. In addition, no refunds will be given for forfeited excursions, transfers, accommodations, or air tickets (100% of air fare is non-refundable).

**Travel Documents:** A valid passport is required of all U.S. citizens. Visas are not required in some countries. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call Creative Destinations Group to determine your visa requirement status. Creative Destinations Group is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

**Tour Documents and Tickets:** Final tour documents are personally handed during orientation or mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.
